

REGULAR ISTANBUL SIGHTSEEING TOURS (08.02.2018 - 31.12.2018)

Byzantine & Ottoman Marvels (KRV1)

Daily departure at around 08:30

Duration: 4 hours

Language: English, French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Arabic

Minimum Participant: 1 pax Price: EUR 29. -per person

Price Includes: Pick up and drop off from city center hotels, entrance fees, guiding services, A/C transportation and parking.

TOUR PROGRAM:

• After breakfast, we will start our full day sightseeing tour of Istanbul. First we will visit the **Blue Mosque**, famous for its blue Iznik (modern name: Nicaea) tiles and unique with its' 6 minarets. After the Blue mosque, we will walk to the **Hippodrome**, which was the center of sports events (chariots races and athletic games) and political activities in the old city. From the Hippodrome, we will walk to **Hagia Sophia**, which is right across from the Blue Mosque. Built as the church of divine wisdom, it is still one of the greatest marvels of architecture in the World. The Byzantine Emperor Justinian constructed it as a basilica in the 6th century. We will end the day after a visit to the **Grand Bazaar**. It is the biggest oriental bazaar (market) in the world with around 4,000 shops, which sell antiques, jewelry, gold, carpets, leather, etc.

CLOSED

Hagia Sophia is closed on Mondays and replaced with Underground Cistern.

Grand Covered Bazaar is closed on Sundays and replaced with authentic shops around Grand Bazaar.

Byzantine & Ottoman Wonders (KRV2)

Daily departure at around 13:30

Duration: 3,5 hours

Language: English, French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Arabic

Minimum Participant: 1 pax Price: EUR 29. -per person

Price Includes: Pick up and drop off from/to city center hotels, entrance fees, guiding services, A/C transportation and

parking.

TOUR PROGRAM:

We will visit the **Topkapi Palace Museum**, which was the imperial residence of Ottoman Sultans. Today in the rooms of this palace, there are exhibits of the imperial treasury, Chinese porcelain, weapons, and holy relics (**the Sword of King David, the staff of Moses, the Turban of Joseph, Relics of St. John the Baptist**). (*Harem is a separate museum and is not included in the program*)

After the visit of Topkapi Palace, our tour director will take you to the **monumental tombs of the Sultans**.

CLOSED

Topkapı Palace is closed on Tuesdays and replaced with Tour to Bosphorus and Spice Market.

Byzantine & Ottoman Complete (KRV 3)

Daily departure at around 08:15

Duration: 8 hours

TOUR PROGRAM:

After breakfast, we will start our full day sightseeing tour of Istanbul. First we will visit the **Blue Mosque**, famous for its blue Iznik (modern name: Nicaea) tiles and unique with its' 6 minarets. After the Blue mosque, we will walk to the **Hippodrome**, which was the center of sports events (chariots races and athletic games) and political activities in the old city. From the Hippodrome, we will walk to **Hagia Sophia**, which is right across from the Blue Mosque. Built as the church of divine wisdom, it is still one of the greatest marvels of architecture in the World. The Byzantine Emperor Justinian constructed it as a basilica in the 6th century. In the afternoon, we will continue with a tour of the **Topkapi Palace Museum**, which was the imperial residence of Ottoman Sultans. TOUR PROGRAM:

TOUR PROGRAM:

We will start the day with a **Bosporus Cruise** on a regular boat. During the boat ride along the strait separating Asia and Europe, we will see imperial palaces, old Ottoman wooden mansions, Ottoman fortresses, embassy estates, and small fishing villages located on the Asian and European sides of Istanbul.

The **Spice Market** will be our second visit. Built in the 17th century, this is **the second largest oriental covered bazaar** in Istanbul. In the Spice Market, the enchanting and savory aroma of exotic oils, herbs and spices hang in the air. People looking for herbs, spices, tea and Turkish delight (candy) have frequented this 350-year-old market for centuries. Whirling Dervishes, a well-recognized symbol of Turkey, are in fact members of the Sufi Order of Islam, or the Mevlevi—followers of the 13th century poet and mystic Mevlana Celaddin Rumi. At the historic Hodja Pasha you will witness a sema whirling ceremony which represents a mystical journey of man's spiritual ascent, accompanied by the haunting, mournful music of the traditional ney reed flute.
